ACT 1

1. LIGHTS UP ON A LOAN FIGURE ON STAGE.

NARRATOR

Previously on 'Hantomime': Hanno the Lion was depressed that he was held captive, and wanted to experience freedom, especially over Christmas. His friends, Jackov the zebra, Helga the hippo, and Morris the giraffe tried to cheer him up, but failed. MEANWHILE, old security guard, ROD, retired, and trained his night quard replacement, Gareth. Gareth is an idiot. Taking advantage of Gareth's incompetence, Hanno broke out of the zoo, leading his friends to track him down with Gareth and Rod ALSO tracking them down.

Let's see, what else happened. Helga and Jackov flirted a bit, but that was weird so we probably won't revisit that. Gareth and Morris met, Gareth seemed a bit in love with Morris (#NoHomo), but Morris was pretty chill about it. Hanno scared a kid and realized maybe he shouldn't be free. They found Hanno, and then Rod found them. He tried to trang the animals but Gareth jumped in the way to save Morris. Someone said something and they all went back to the zoo together as friends to have Christmas dinner, and promised to do

the same thing every year. They also decided to blame the wolves for the chaos, because screw wolves, am I right?

To be honest, I'm doing this recap from memory, but I think that's everything important...and by important I mean "going to be referenced in this one".

Also, writing these in rhyme is both hard, and not worth the pay off, so I'm not doing that this time.

LIGHTS FADE.

2. EXT. ZOO ENCLOSURE. EVENING.

The zoo has just closed for the day. HANNO, JACKOV, HELGA, MORRIS, and GARETH are bringing a table and chairs on stage in preparation for their now annual Christmas meal.

GARETH

Now that the zoo is closed and everyone's gone- we can get ready for our annual Christmas meal!

JACKOV

We know, we're all here! Why are you explaining what we're doing when we all know?

MORRIS

(in a knowing tone)
It's an expositional tool
used by lazy writers to let
the audience know what's

happening without putting in any effort.

JACKOV

What are you talking about? We literally JUST acknowledged that there is no audience, because everyone just went home!

HELGA

Just leave it, Jackov.

JACKOV

(obviously annoyed)
Don't call me that- I go by
Jack now!

MORRIS

Makes sense, we did mine that joke pretty hard last year!

JACKOV

Giggity.

HELGA

So the name Jackov is too immature now, but you keep making cheap innuendos?

JACKOV

(shrugs)

HANNO

Come on guys, it's Christmas time! Let's not get down on each other.

(Music starts playing) Christmas time is a time to sing,

That's what Christmas is for

MORRIS

Christmas can even be a Hannakuh thing,

That's what Christmas is for

HELGA

And for a huge percentage of this God-fearing planet, It's about the birth of Jesus Chr-i-ist!

HANNO

Buuut, for the rest of us it's still a good time,
To remember that it's good to be nice

JACKOV

Music and cookies and liquer and trees, That's what Christmas is for,

GARETH

Video games for two straight weeks, That's what Christmas is for

MORRIS

Hanging out with the people you love, And saying-

MORRIS AND GARETH

'I love yooooou!'

EVERYONE

That's what Christmas is
That's what Christmas is
That's what Christmas is for!

(The song ends in a big
crescendo the holds their
final poses for a few
seconds)

ZAK

Okay...what was that? Why did you guys all just burst into song like that? And did one of shout about a...Christmas pterodactyl?

HANNO

(Shrugging)

It's Christmas. Last year we had a big adventure, and then we had a meal, and decided to do it all again this year!

MORRIS

A sequel.

ZAK

The same again as last year?

HANNO

Yeah, but even bigger and better

MORRIS

And with updated jokes

GARETH

Who are you anyway?

ZAK

I'm zak...I'm part of the new peacock enclosure.

JACKOV

(to GARETH)

How do you not know that- YOU WORK HERE!

GARETH looks embarrassed

MORRIS

It helps with exposition

HANNO

Guys, we're starting to fight again- lets just get on with the meal

They finish bringing in the table and all the chairs and all take a seat. One seat remains empty.

HANNO

Why's there an empty seat? Who's missing?

HELGA

Yeah, where's Rod?

GARETH

Oh yeah, he had a meeting, he told me to let you guys know he was going to be late

JACKOV

(sarcastically)
Well, thanks for passing on the message

GARETH

(missing the irony and feeling pleased with himself) You're welcome

HELGA

Well while we're waiting we might as well start on the crackers

Everyone grabs a cracker and pulls it with someone else

GARETH

(unravelling the joke)
I love the jokes in these
things:
What's E.T short for?

EVERYONE looks like they are trying to think of the answer

HANNO

Duuno, what is E.T short for?

GARETH

(confused)

...He's got little legs?

(EVERYONE groans at the bad

joke)

I don't get it! What's having little legs got to do with E.T?

ZAK

Well, E.T's legs are little aren't they?

GARETH

You mean the alien?

HELGA

Yeah, so that's why he's short

GARETH

But what's that got to do with the letters?

HANNO

That's the joke!

GARETH

OHHHHH...no, wait, I still don't get it

JACKOV

How are you this thick?

At this point ROD walks in, saving GARETH from his embarrassment

ROD

Hi everyone, sorry I'm so late, just got out of a meeting with the board.

HANNO

How was it?

ROD

Well, to be blunt: we're sausaged.

HANNO

What? How?

ROD

They want to shut down the zoo. They don't think it's profitable enough.

ZAK

What's that got to do with sausages?

MORRIS

It's just something we do instead of swearing- just go with it.

HANNO

How can they say we're not profitable enough?

ROD

Someone on the board was trying to convince them that the village puts £350 million into the zoo every year, and that if we didn't we'd be able to put that money into other things

HELGA

Like what?

ROD

Like Nigel's Home Stores

HELGA

What's that?

ROD

It's a shop in town. It was

set up by a guy called 'Nigel'. It's a play on British Home Stores- you know, BHS

HANNO

So this would be NHS?

ROD

Exactly, the argument is that they will have the £350 million to invest in NHS, and things like that

HANNO

That's ridiculous

HELGA

Yeah, us being here means the local shops get AT LEAST that much back from tourists

MORRIS

Not to mention the improvements it's lead to in transport

JACKOV

And increases in employment

ZAK

And all the money the zoo puts into the community

GARETH

AND...

(trying to think of something
 to add)
I haven't said anything in a
while

EVERYONE stares at GARETH for a moment

HANNO

Is there anything we can do?

ROD

I don't think so. They took a vote. It was 52% in favour of shutting the zoo.

JACKOV

That's bull-sausage!

HELGA

That's so close

ROD

Well, the general attitude was leaning the other way, then they were reminded of those wolves that escaped last year, and run amuck. There were a few people on the fence that were scared enough that that would happen again, and think we need to be more careful about allowing dangerous animals into our community.

JACKOV

By banning all animals? But that doesn't make any sense?

HELGA

Next they'll be wanting to close our bookshop!

MORRIS

Borders?

HELGA

Yeah! Next they'll be wanting to close Borders!

HANNO

Wait, you said it was because of the wolves that finally pushed people to vote to close the zoo?

ROD

(looking grim)
That's right

HANNO

(the guilt settling in)
But it wasn't really the
wolves that did it. It was
us...it was me.

As the reality of the situation sinks in EVERYONE is left in a stunned silence.

HELGA

We've got to do something

ZAK

It doesn't sound like there's much that we can do, if what Rod said is right, the decisions been made!

GARETH

What if we all voted to have a revote?

JACKOV

How would that help? 52% of people would still just vote not to revote.

GARETH

It was just a suggestion

HELGA

Well we should do SOMETHING

ROD

Helga's right. We can't sit down and do nothing. I think Gareth might be onto something-

GARETH suddenly leaps back, looking for the thing that he is "on". ROD doesn't pause for the distraction.

-we can't officially move forward with anything for three months. It allows for the village people to appeal the decision.

HANNO

(Starting to lighten up again)
So we've got three months to try and change their minds?

ROD

Exactly. I'll use that time to try and swing the people on the fence back in our favour.

HANNO

And we need to go out all out to make sure the people of Kidlington want to keep us around.

GARETH

How will going out help? That's what got us into this mess!

MORRIS puts a hand on GARETH'S shoulder and shakes his head sympathetically

HANNO

We'll do every we can to make sure that people come and visit us, and when they do that they want to come back!

JACKOV

How are we going to do that?

ZAK

It should be easy now that we've got the peacock enclosure: I am really beautiful.

HANNO

We all just keep doing what we're doing, but we will do it the best we can.

MORRIS

We'll be busier than Dylan's phone on summer camp

HELGA

We have literally no idea what you're talking about

MORRIS

Yeah, it was for them (indicates the audience)

EVERYONE else peers into the audience, they look confused, apparently not seeing the audience

JACKOV

Why does he always get like this at this time of year?

HANNO

I think we can do this guys: I think we can save the zoo!

EVERYONE cheers.

EVERYONE FILTERS OFF TALKING EXCITEDLY. LIGHTS FADE.

3. EXT. ZOO ENCLOSURE. DAYTIME- JUST BEFORE OPENING.

HANNO

Okay guys, we all know what we're doing?

JACKOV

Yes, they walk in, we attack and eat all of their faces.

HELGA

Give it a rest, Jack. You

know he's nervous about this.

JACKOV

That doesn't mean that we can't follow instructions after being given them a million times

GARETH runs in. His shirt is tucked in, but poking out of his zipper.

GARETH

Sorry I'm late, did I miss much

JACKOV

Okay. Most of us.

GARETH

Pardon?

HANNO

Nothing, we were just finalising the plan and make sure we all know what we're doing.

GARETH

Perfect, I've been practicing all night!

HELGA

Errrr, practicing?

GARETH

(happily)

Yeah!

ROD

(off-stage)

Okay guys, into position: here they come

The "customers" for the day come in. The audience now

represents the customers. HANNO breaks into a dance, twirling his tail seductively and making suggestive beckoning motions at members of the audience. ZAK starts vogueing and modelling. JACKOV starts pooping. HELGA pulls out a rope and starts skipping. MORRIS stands there, deep in thought. For some reason, GARETH starts doing lunges. This carries on for a while, everyone focused on their own activity.

HANNO

(noticing GARETH and walking over to him) What are you doing?

GARETH

I'm doing my part- I'm
entertaining the visitors!

HANNO

You're not an exhibit at the zoo. You work here. No-one is looking at you!

GARETH

Yes they are!

HANNO

That's because your shirt is sticking out of your zipper!

GARETH corrects this, looking highly embarrassed.

Trust me. Nothing about what
you are doing is attracting
attention for the right
reason.

GARETH leaves looking really sorry for himself.

HELGA

(walking over to HANNO) Hanno, that was really mean.

JACKOV

(joining them)
Yeah, that was a real sausage

move.

A KID runs over to HANNO

KID

Mummy, look a lion! Lion, do the roar!

HANNO

(Ignoring the kid)
Guys, we've got a job to do
here. In case you've
forgotten, I'm trying to save
the zoo, not Gareth's
feelings!

KID

Do the roar.

HELGA

But if you isolate everyone to do it, what are you saving?

KID

Do the roar.

HANNO

Wow, so deep. Thanks for the advice. Now can I get back to work?

KID

Do the roar.

JACKOV

Why are you being such a sausage hole about this?

KID

Do the roar.

HANNO

BECAUSE IT'S ALL MY FAULT THE

ZOO IS CLOSING, SO I HAVE TO SAVE IT.

KID

Do the roar.

HANNO suddenly snaps, turning and roaring in the kids face. Everything else stops, and EVERYONE stares at HANNO shocked. The silence hangs for moment. The KID starts crying. HANNO runs off, ashamed.

LIGHTS FADE.

4. EXT. ZOO ENCLOSURE. EVENING- AFTER CLOSING.

HANNO, HELGA, MORRIS, JACKOV, and ZAK are all on stage looking dejected.

ROD

(walking on stage)
Well. That could have gone
better.

JACKOV

Gone better? It was a complete-

MORRIS

(overcutting the impending use of bad language)
SAUSAGE

JACKOV

-show. There's no coming back from that.

HELGA

(realising how miserable
HANNO is, and trying to get
JACKOV to realise he's being
insensitive)
It wasn't THAT bad

JACKOV

Are you kidding? After that show, even a sausage sandwich is more popular than us.

ZAK

Yeah, but sausage sandwiches are delic-oh wait, I get it.

HELGA

It's really not that bad. We've come back from worse!

JACKOV

Yeah right! Even Jesus couldn't come back from that one.

HELGA

Jack, seriously. Shut up!

JACKOV

Why?

HANNO

Yeah? Why should he? He's right! We're screwed. And it's all my fault.

HELGA

No, it's not. Besides, there's still time with the board. Right, Rod?

ROD

(scratching his head, and sounding hesitant) Welll, I suppose anything's possible!

HANNO

See. Even trying to encourage me, he can't muster much hope. It's over.

ROD

I didn't say that. It's not over, until it's over.

ZAK

Makes sense.

HELGA

We can still do this! We just need to work harder!

HANNO

We tried that. I gave it my all, and I cracked under the pressure. I messed it up for all of us, and as a result, we're even deeper in the sausage. Not only that, but it's MY fault we're even in this situation in the first place. You guys are better off without me!

HANNO leaves to the protests of everyone else. They go to follow him, but as he's leaving, GARETH enters looking excited, and trips over his own feet, sprawling across the floor. The gang gathers around GARETH, making sure he's okay, and in the confusion, HANNO slips away.

GARETH

I'm okay. I'm okay.

HELGA

(Looking around and seeing that HANNO is gone)
Guys, he's gone.

GARETH

No I'm not. I said I'm fine!

JACKOV

(also looking around)
Not you, you idiot! Hanno!

GARETH

Where's he gone?

MORRIS

He thought our case was hopeless, and thought it was his fault. So he left feeling sorry for himself. But he'll be back.

HELGA

I wouldn't be so sure. I've never seen him that low before, and he seemed pretty revolved in leaving. What makes you think he'll be back?

MORRIS

Because his name is in the title of the pantomime and we're only just reaching the end of act one!

HELGA, JACKOV, ZAK, and ROD are all staring at MORRIS like he's mental

GARETH

(standing up and dusting himself off, oblivious to MORRIS' weird comments) That's what I came to tell you! We're not going to have to close- that's what I came to tell you!

ZAK

(sounding skeptical)
I know I'm new to this group,
but I can't say that you've
said much so far that's got
me excited about a plan
coming from you.

JACKOV

I hate to say it, but we've

not exactly got many options.

HELGA

Yeah, we might as well hear him out.

GARETH

Well, I was thinking about being caught with my fly down earlier, and how embarrassed I was. Then it hit me: we need to catch them with their fly down!

JACKOV

Okay. I was wrong. It wasn't worth hearing him out.

ZAK

How will seeing them with their zipper down help us?

GARETH

No. It's an idiom! An expression! We don't need to literally catch anyone with their fly down. What I mean is that we can hack into the computer, and not only find out who it is on the board that's pushing to close the zoo, but we can also find out what they've got against the zoo, and persuade them to stop this campaign against us!

JACKOV

That's...actually not a bad idea

ROD

Guys, wouldn't we be better off sticking to the plan? Do any of us even know how to hack? I mean, it's a plan from GARETH!

HELGA

We've got nothing to lose from trying it!

ZAK

Plus I look really good in black.

MORRIS

Makes sense from a narrative point of view!

HELGA

Okay guys, let's go!

They all run off stage, excited.

LIGHT'S FADE.

5. EMPTY STAGE.

THE NARRATOR enters

NARRATOR

Is Hanno gone forever?
Will the gang's plan work?
Will GARETH be the one to
save the day?
Can any of them actually hack
a computer?
Will the acting get any
better in the second half?
Find out next act, on
HANTOMIME!

LIGHT'S FADE.

6. EMPTY STAGE.

THE NARRATOR enters

NARRATOR

(as if reading the news) Good evening ladies and gentlemen, welcome to the (insert time here) news. I'm currently standing at the Kidlington zoo, where earlier this evening news came in that the zoo might be closing. The animals at this establishment banded together in a brave attempt to prevent this from happening, and to maintain the quality of life they had established since arriving here. The plan, however, failed, and a desolate Hanno the lion has left the zoo forever, feeling helpless and alone. In a last-ditch attempt, a dimwitted zoo guard has come up with a plan to save them all. Stayed tuned for more updates on this story as it unfolds.

THE NARRATOR walks off stage.

LIGHT'S FADE.

7. INT. ZOO OFFICE. DOES A ZOO HAVE AN OFFICE? DOESN'T MATTER, NO-ONE READS THESE THINGS AWAY. WHEREEVER THE COMPUTER IS AT THE ZOO. STAFF ROOM?

GARETH walks in acting all "stealth", he is humming the mission impossible theme tune, and rolling, and crawling around as if he is avoiding lasers, and sneaking around. This goes on for some time. MORRIS and ZAK walk in behind him, casually.

ZAK

What are you doing?

GARETH

Being stealth!

ZAK

(looking around)
From what? There's nothing
here!

GARETH

(looking a bit embarrassed)
Well it doesn't hurt to be
careful!

MORRIS

Come on guys, we've got a job to do, which way from here, Gareth?

GARETH

Definitely right!

ZAK

The only options are left or straight ahead!

GARETH

Oh. Ummm, straight ahead, no left, no straight ahead. Wait...I don't know.

ZAK

How can you not know? You work here!

GARETH

Because the other workers don't let me hang out here, they always make me stay outside!

MORRIS

That's so mean! Why?

GARETH

Probably because I spend all my time talking to animals. It's not exactly mentally healthy!

ZAK

(cuttingly)
It's not great for our mental
health either.

MORRIS

Let's just go this way. If it's not right, we'll just retrace our steps.

They all walk off stage.

LIGHT'S FADE.

8. EXT. A STREET IN KIDLINGTON. NIGHTIME.

HANNO sits by himself looking forlorn

HANNO

I can't believe I've ruined everything! It's all over because of me. How could I be so stupid? Not only have I ended the chance that we might get to stay up, I got caught up in my own emotions and left! How is that going to help anything? The zoo is screwed, I've left and have no where to go, which is exactly the issue that started this whole mess last year, and now, I'm expositing to myself! This whole thing is a sausage nightmare! (sigh)

I can't exactly go back though. It's my fault they're in this mess, they must hate me! I guess I just need to resign myself to the fact that from now on...I'm all by myself.

All By Myself stars playing in the background, HANNO sings along, sobbing.

All by myself, Don't wanna be, All by myself, Anymore.

All by myself, Don't wanna live, All by myself, Anymore.

HANNO breaks down into tears, with the music still playing.

LIGHTS FADE.

9. INT. THE BUILDING THAT MORRIS, ZAK, AND GARETH WERE IN PREVIOUSLY. THE ONE THAT MIGHT BE A STAFF ROOM/OFFICE. NIGHTTIME.

MORRIS, ZAK, and GARETH are all looking lost.

GARETH

It's got to be around here somewhere

ZAK

You've been saying that for an hour

GARETH

And it's still true!

ZAK

You are such an idiot! This building is so small, AND YOU WORK HERE- how are we lost?

MORRIS

Shut up you guys!

GARETH

Yeah, you tell him, Morrisleave me alone!

MORRIS

No, someone's coming, be quiet.

They try to hide, but they're in a corridor so it doesn't really work. KAREN walks on stage.

KAREN

Gareth?

GARETH

No.

KAREN

Gareth, what are you doing here with these animals?

GARETH

We got lost.

KAREN

You got lost? How did you end up here?

MORRIS

Gareth, who is she? Can she help us?

GARETH

That's Karen, she's the new Mexican security guard.

ZAK

Wow. I mean, at the risk of being "that guy" is the fact that she's Mexican really that important?

MORRIS

It's a reference, the audience love it.

ZAK

Okay...

GARETH

And in answer to your question, let's find out; Karen- do you know where the main computer is?

KAREN

Yes, it's just through that door.

(indicating)

GARETH

Great! Thanks!

GARETH, MORRIS, and ZAK all head in the direction she pointed. KAREN stops them.

KAREN

Woah, what are you doing? I can't let you guys just traipse into the main office...especially as two of you are animals!

GARETH

But, this is really
important!

KAREN

I'm sorry, this is literally my job!

ZAK pulls MORRIS and GARETH aside

ZAK

Don't worry guys. I've got this!

ZAK starts strutting around. He is literally peacocking to try and attract KAREN. It works.

KAREN

Wow...um, could anyone give me a hand putting these tomahawks back in the shed?

ZAK

I'll help you out with that.

ZAK and KAREN walk off stage together.

MORRIS

Okay, the way's clear, let's go!

GARETH

This is just like that film...fantastic four

MORRIS

How is this anything like that?

GARETH

There was just four us!

MORRIS

(stares incredulously for a moment) C'mon, lets get going.

They both run off together.

LIGHTS FADE.

10. EXT. ZOO ENCLOSURE. NIGHTTIME.

JACKOV is sat there, unconcerned. HELGA is pacing.

HELGA

What is taking them so long, they should have done it by now!

JACKOV

Relax, what could have gone wrong?

HELGA

It was plan by Gareth!

JACKOV

Yeah, sorry, let me correct that statement: what could have gone right!

HELGA

That's exactly what I'm worried about!

JACKOV

I wouldn't worry- as you say, it's a Gareth plan, they probably haven't even found the building yet!

HELGA

I just don't feel right about it, and I feel so helpless sat here, not able to do anything about it.

JACKOV

AS you said, we can't do anything about it, so why stress?

HELGA

There's just so much happening! The zoo's closing, Hanno's gone, and our only plan for survival is in the hands of GARETH- a man who thought Game of Thrones was a documentary!

JACKOV

It'll come together thoughit always does!

HELGA

And this time at least we've got Rod and Gareth on our side! We've never really had that before.

JACKOV

Yeah...I'm not sure how much solace that is, but at least you're right. C'mon, let's get back to work!

They head off stage.

LIGHTS FADE.

11. INT. ZOO OFFICE.

MORRIS and GARETH burst into the room.

GARETH

Sausage, I thought this was going to be it

MORRIS

It is it- the computer is right there!

GARETH

Oh...right! Now all I need to do is hack into it

GARETH sits at the computer and starts typing furiously.

GARETH

I've managed to reroute the firewall, and engage the proxy through a backdoor VPN.

MORRIS

Do you have any idea what you're talking about, because I'm pretty sure that was just a load of computer words in a random order!

GARETH

No, whoever used the computer last just didn't sign out! Okay, if we look back through

the e-mails, we should be able to see started this whole mess with the board.

GARETH types some more.

GARETH

(GARETH's mouth falls open)
Oh. My. Gosh. You've got to
be sausage kidding me!

MORRIS

What is it? Did you see their browser history?

GARETH

No. The person who did this, it was-

ROD

(walking in and pointing a
gun at them both)

Me.

GARETH

Rod. Why are you doing this?

ROD

Why am I doing this? Are you kidding? I poured my whole life into this sausage zoo, and what for? Every day of my life, I came here. Every hour of the day, I thought about my job. I worked hard, I was the best! And what do I have to show for it? A sausage pension package that barely covers my mortgage! And not only that, but my wife needed me, and I was here. I left to take better care of her, but it was too late, and now she's gone. She's gone because this place sucked away all my attention, and I

had nothing left to give to her. I did it because all the money that was spent on bringing you filthy animals into the country, could have been spent, could have been spent on healthcare, and that extra money could have helped Tory.

MORRIS

Rod, what are you talking about? You've been blinded by your pain!

ROD

NO! I finally see the truth, and it's too late for you to do anything about it!

GARETH

You're wrong, we'll tell everyone what your plan is!

ROD

(indicating the gun) What do you think this is for?

GARETH

Hmmm. Good point.

MORRIS

We're not the only ones who know we're here though. Zak's with us. He's off distracting Karen right now, but he'll be here any moment now, and he'll rescue us, and put a stop to all of this!

ROD

Oh really? KAREN!

KAREN enters, she has ZAK tied up as a prisoner.

ZAK

I'm really sorry guys- she pulled out the rope, and I thought 'Great!' but then she tied me up and dragged me in here!

KAREN shoves ZAK to stand with MORRIS and GARETH, ROD keeps his gun trained on all of them.

GARETH

We still have Jack and Helga, they know we're here, and they'll come and get us out if we don't show up by morning!

ROD

Good point. Karen, go and sort out the Hippo and the Zebra.

KAREN exits.

ROD

And with HANNO gone, and the rest of you held here, the zoo will be just a few birds, a couple of penguins and the reptile house. Pretty soon people will stop coming, and the board will have to shut the zoo. You guys have just made my job so much easier!

ROD cackles manically.

LIGHTS FADE.

12. EMPTY STAGE.

NARRATOR enters.

NARRATOR

So, I know what you're

thinking: 'this is meant to be a pantomime! It's meant to be funny, and light, with songs, and jokes. This is dark!'

Well kids, that's life sometimes! I mean, this is quite dark, but it's got some funny bits in, right? We had a couple of songs! We've got another one coming up in a couple of scenes! And a lot of the darkness is just reflecting real life! I mean, Rod's wife was called Tory because he's clearly a Brexit-pushing conservative-did you get that reference? Pretty funny right!

Anyway, try to remember it's all just a bit of fun, and we'll try to keep it that way!

LIGHTS FADE.

13. EXT. ZOO ENCLOSURE. NIGHT TIME.

HELGA and JACKOV are still waiting, but they're starting to get tired. HELGA is still pacing. JACKOV is sat on a bench.

JACKOV

Look, will you calm down? They said not to worry until morning, and it's barely even night time!

HELGA

I know, it's just so nerveracking not knowing what's going on! Our fate is in the balance, and we have no way of knowing how they're doing. And now we don't even have the distraction of the zoo being open!

JACKOV

Helga, you're more on edge than Kim Jong-un, get some rest.

HELGA

But I want to find out how it's gone as soon as they get back

JACKOV

Look, just go to sleep, I'll stay up, and as soon as they're back, I'll let you know.

HELGA

(yawning)
Thanks, Jack- I am pretty
tired.

HELGA lies down on the bench next to JACKOV and falls straight to sleep. JACKOV settles in to keep watch. KAREN sneaks in behind JACKOV. A rousing game of "she's behind you" strikes up with the audience. Every time KAREN manages to hide, avoiding detection by JACKOV. Eventually, KAREN gets behind JACKOV and knocks him out with a bat.

LIGHTS FADE

14. EXT. A STREET IN KIDLINGTON. NIGHTIME

HANNO is sat by himself.

HANNO

I don't get it. I ran away, I learnt my lesson. I sang a sad song: why has no-one come to pull me out of my funk yet? I was SURE they would have come by now!

NARRATOR

(walking on stage)
It's because there's no-one
left

HANNO

(startled)
Who are you?

NARRATOR

Im the narrator, my name is Deus Ex Machina...you can call me "Duey".

HANNO

Okay, Duey. What do you mean there's no-one left, are the others in trouble?

DUEY

Yes. They would have come to save you- they really care about you, but they're a bit tied up at the moment

(laughs)

You'll find that really funny in a minute- they've all been kidnapped by Rod, and his accomplice, Karen, and it's up to you to save them.

HANNO

Me? Save them? I've only ever made things worse! I can't do anything right! If I got ot save them, they'll probably end up dead.

DUEY

Or worse, expelled.

HANNO

Expelled? From what?

DUEY

It was a Harry Potter

reference, look, don't worry about that, you need to worry about saving them. As I said, they really care about you. I know that they wouldn't worry about messing up, or not being good enough before rushing of to save you...again. They'd put everything else aside to get you out of whatever kind of mess you were in! Hell, they're in this mess, because they were trying to tie up the loose ends from the mess that you made last year.

HANNO

But... I'm scared

DUEY

You should be. But this isn't something you should do because you can, it's something you should do because you can't not do everything you can to save your friends. So you need to put on your big boy pants, and lion the sausage up. What d'you say?

"No Way" starts Playing

HANNO

My mind is racing, but my heart, it beats faster, I'm in control, commander and master, Lady Fate, creating disaster, But she ain't the boss of me,

Head on collision with a catastrophic setback,
Makes you either want to get lost, or get back,
I choose the latter; let's

not forget that,
We hold the cards this time,
so there's no need to bitch
or whine!

There's no way,
I'm gonna take another
option,
No way I'm gonna settle with
a loss!
No way I'm gonna sit around
and watch,
There's no, no way...

There's no way,
You're gonna find me in the
background,
No damn way you're gonna see
me satisfied!
No way they're ever gonna
make me back down,
No, no way...

DUEY

Home field advantage, The upper hand is ours, So the game is on!

The clock ticks, But we've got our tricks To fuss with and fix what's wrong!

HANNO

Let's wake up and go, guys, Take out the bad guys, Break out your mad eyes—

HANNO AND DUEY

YEAH!

We'll take it on together, We're stronger and we're better And if there's a problem--"Ha"--Whatever! There's no way
We're gonna leave it up to
chance,
There's no damn way we're
gonna go without a fight!
No way you're gonna see us on
our ass,
There's no, no way...

There's no way
We're gonna settle with
sorrow,
Leave right now if you think
this ain't real!
Today, not waitin' for
tomorrow!

No, no way there's no way, No, no way there's no way, No, no way there's no way, There's. No. Waaaaaaay!

SONG ENDS. LIGHTS FADE.

15. EXT. OUTSIDE THE MAIN OFFICE. NIGHT TIME.

KAREN is guarding the door to the main office. DUEY and HANNO are on stage, hidden from KAREN.

DUEY

Okay, that's the one that that's working with Rod.

HANNO

Why would she team up with him? What's she got against us?

DUEY

She's allergic to animals, so she wants to get rid of you all.

HANNO

That doesn't make ANY sense!

Why would she get a job here then? How do you even know all of this?

DUEY

I dunno- I'm the narrator. Whatever I say becomes true, so even if that isn't true, it is now! Here's the plan, I'll go talk to her, then you sneak up behind her. That will make her sneeze and drop her gun, which I'll then grab. We'll then tie her up, and steal her walkie talkie. Then, when you're in position, I'll radio Rod to come out here, and you go in, and save your friends.

HANNO

Will that really work?

DUEY

I just said it didn't I?

DUEY walks over to KAREN

DUEY

I think I'm lost

KAREN

I'd say so- the zoo's closed, you're going to have to leave.

DUEY

Oh, I'm really sorry, I must not have heard when the zoo was closing, could you please show me out.

As KAREN is explaining to DUEY how to leave the zoo, HANNO sneaks behind her, causing her to sneeze, and drop the gun. DUEY quickly grabs the gun and points it at KAREN.

DUEY

See, I told you it would work! Now, grab her walkie, and tie her up.

HANNO takes KAREN off-stage. DUEY follows.

LIGHTS FADE.

16. LIGHTS UP. INT. THE OFFICE. NIGHT TIME.

MORRIS, GARETH, ZAK, HELGA, and JACKOV are all tied up. ROD is holding them all hostage.

HELGA

You'll never get away with this!

ROD

Oh, don't be so dramatic. What is this, some cheesy film?

MORRIS

Kind of. More of a crappy
pantomime.

ROD

Anyway, I've already got away with it. The board's meeting first thing tomorrow to discuss the worrying matter that for the second year in a row, all the lead attractions have escaped from the zoo.

JACKOV

I thought they didn't know about last year?

ROD

Actually, they did. I told them that you all escaped with the wolves, and that the wolves were the only ones I wasn't able to round up. They applauded me as a hero, while I've been setting you guys up all year!

HELGA

You're disgusting

ROD

No- I'm a hero. And in 12 hours, the world will see you the way I do: a plague on this great village.

KAREN'S voice comes in from off-stage, clearly broadcasted from the walkie talkie.

KAREN

Err, boss, we've got a situation out here, can you out front pronto. Over.

ROD

(into the walkie)
I'm on my way. Over.
 (to the animals)
I'd tell you to stay put, but
It's not like you're going
anywhere.

ROD exits. Moments later HANNO pops his head round the corner.

HANNO

(whispering)
Is the coast clear?

EVERYONE

HANNO!

HANNO

SHHHH!!! Don't shout or Rod will hear you. Look, we don't have much time before he's back. We've tied up Karen,

but it won't take long before Rod realises that, and he'll come straight back here knowing that something is up. What I need is for you to distract Rod while, then I'll take him out from behind.

GARETH

I've got just the thing- it's sure to confuse him!

HANNO

Are you sure- well, I hope so, here he comes!

HANNO jumps behind something to hide. ROD and KAREN run in. ROD's still holding his gun, they're both a little out of breath.

ROD

HA! You're all still here!

ZAK

As you said, where would we go?

ROD

Someone's attacked Karen, obviously they know you're here.

KAREN

It was that lion

HELGA

Hanno? It can't have been- he left!

GARETH

Hey, Rod, why are E.T's legs short? SAUSAGE, I mean, what's E.T short for?

ROD

He's got little legs.

GARETH

(disappointed)
What? How did you get it so
quickly?

HANNO suddenly bursts out from his hiding place. ROD quickly turns and shoots him. HANNO collapses to the floor.

HANNO

OWWWW! Sausage! Why did I think that that would work? This hurts so much!

ROD

You're a fool. You thought you could change any of this, just by wanting it enough? That's not how life works.

HANNO

That's it! We need Duey!

JACKOV

Who is Duey?

ZAK

Is he one of those three ducks?

HANNO

No, he's the Narrator!

ZAK

The what?

MORRIS

That guy who keeps showing up and needlessly explaining what we've just seen happen!

JACKOV

How do you know him?

MORRIS

I just know stuff!

HANNO

Anyway, anything he says, happens! If we get him to come here, he can save us. We all just need to call his name. On three everyone: 1...2...3...

EVERYONE

DUUEEEYYY!!!!

DUEY walks on stage. ROD points his gun at DUEY.

DUEY

And then Rod lowered his gun.

ROD lowers his gun, looking bewildered, as if it's against his will.

DUEY

What's up, Hanno? What do you need?

HANNO

We're in a bit of a mess here, we need you to describe a way to get us out of this.

DUEY

Okay...let's see.

As DUEY describes situations, the characters act out what is being described.

DUEY

And then, Rod slowly started to raise his gun. It looks like he's aiming it at Duey again, but then it keeps rising until it's pointing at his own head. And then he-

EVERYONE

NO!!

DUEY

What?

HANNO

Too dark!

HELGA

Waaaayy too dark!

JACKOV

You can't just kill people, that's murder.

ZAK

Yeah, kind of illegal.

DUEY

Eurgh. Fine.

(thinking for a moment)

Okay, got it. Everyone started spontaneously dancing.

Saturday Night start playing. EVERYONE except DUEY jumps up into a line and starts dancing along.

HELGA

(after a few times doing the dance)

How exactly is this supposed to help?

DUEY

(laughing)

It isn't, but it's soo funny! Alright, alright, they all stop.

EVERYONE stops dancing.

DUEY

Hmm, let's see. Okay, I think I've got it. And then, Rod turns around and walks away, taking Karen with him, never to be seen by the rest of the gang-

HELGA

Wait, what if he has a change of heart

ZAK

Or we need to foil his plans again

MORRIS

Or if it makes narrative sense for him to pop up again next year

DUEY

Okay- never to be seen again by the gang unless they need to for the next pantomime.

ROD and KAREN walk off-stage unceremoniously.

JACKOV.

Well. That was surprisingly easy.

ZAK

Yeah. Almost disappointingly so.

HELGA

We're not out of the woods yet, what about the board?

DUEY

I've got this: and with Rod no longer pushing the board,

they all unanimously decided to keep the zoo open.

HELGA

Well then. I guess that's that.

HANNO

Ummm, guys. I hate to be all "me, me, me" but I'M BLEEDING OUT HERE!

JACKOV

Oh sausage- yeah.

GARETH

I've got this

GARETH pulls out an orange bandanna.

GARETH

Good job we gave these out to everyone last year!

GARETH ties the bandanna around HANNO'S wound.

HELGA

Well guys, same again enxt year?

JACKOV

Of course, but do we have to invite this guy (indicates DUEY)

ZAK

Yeah, it's a bit boring when he can just solve everything by saying it.

MORRIS

He is very overpowered.

HANNO

Guys, guys, guys. If we've learnt anything from Rod, it should be that we should have superior attitudes and exclude people. Having said that, yeah, this guy did sort of create an anti-climax, so maybe we shouldn't invite him.

DUEY

I'm right here, guys!

HELGA

(ignoring DUEY and raising a
 toast)
For saving the zoo, and
keeping us employed, here's
to us!

EVERYONE

(also raising imaginary
 glasses)
TO US!

DUEY

(Stepping forward and addressing the audience) Well, another panto is done, and everyhing's wrapped up nicely! Thanks for staying with us, and for most of you not falling asleep! We hope you've enjoyed it as much as we have, although hopefully you all appreciate a proper hero when you see one, rather than writing them off as a literal Deus Ex Machina, and accuse them of being an anticlimax...not that I'm bitter or anything! Anyway- see you all next time!!
